## Nisan 17 short item

- The other Sirs will tell you, I'm useless at times and dates.
  - And they're right.
  - I just don't like them.
  - I find times and dates **boring**
- But I really find one date interesting...even fascinating!
- The **Jewish calendar** is **different** from our **European** calendar.
  - For example their month of Nisan falls between our March and April (Spring), and was their 1st month.
  - It wasn't always the first, it used to be the 7th month in Noah's day.
  - But God tells Moses to change it to the first month, on the **first Passover**, just before the people come out of Egypt (Ex. 12:2).
- **Numbers** are **significant**, symbolically, in the Bible.
  - For example the number **10** conveys the concept of **perfection and totality**.
  - And the number **7** conveys the concept of **completeness**—that of something **being finished** or done. It is closely **associated with God** the **Divine number**.
  - The number 8 conveys the concept of salvation.

    Eight people came out of the Ark for example.
- If you put **10 and 7 together** you get **17**.
- And there's something very strange about the 17th day of the first month Nisan throughout the Bible.
  - It seems to suggest a fresh start- new beginnings first fruit.
- On that very date Noah's Ark comes to rest on Mount Ararat, saving his family (Gen 8:4)
- On that very date the **Hebrews entered Egypt** after being reconciled with Joseph. (Exo 12:40-41)
- Exactly 430 yrs after they'd entered, down to the same day, they left Egypt before crossing over the parted Red Sea to be free from slavery. (Exo 3:18, 5:3)
- On that very date **Israel entered** and **ate the first fruit of the Promised Land** after eating manna in the wilderness (Joshua 5:10-12)
- The **Temple** was **cleansed** and **renewed by Hezekiah**, eight hundred years after entering the promised land, on 17th Nisan (2 Chronicles 29:1-28)

- On Nisan 17, Queen Esther saved the Jews from genocide (Esther 3:12, 5:1)
- You may say,
   "but it may just be written by the authors of the Bible to seem significant. but these things didn't really happen on that date"
- But this was recorded by different authors and the dates were well known history before the subsequent events happened, and it's impossible to think that they had been organised to fall exactly when they did.
- This is **most clear** with the **last event**.
  - These **previous** events were written and **well known** in the **Old Testament** Scriptures no one can deny that, even if they want to.
  - **Then something else** happens.
- 3 days after his death on Nisan 15th (the Friday) on the 8th day (symbolic of salvation) on the Sunday, Jesus the Messiah was resurrected.
- The date this happened would have been on the 17th of Nisan!
- This was the Jewish feast of First Fruits and Resurrection Sunday.
  - It was the greatest of all **New Beginnings**...
  - It is the very **crux** of the **Christian faith**, when **sin** and **death** were **defeated**, and is **how people** may be **born again** to a **new beginning**, to **bear fruit of repentance**.
- The **odds** of **just two** of these events both happening accidentally on the same day of the Hebrew year (360 days) are **1 in 129,000**.
- The odds of all these events all happening coincidentally on the same day of the Hebrew year are 1 in 783 quadrillion, 864 trillion, 876 Billion, 960 Million (783,864,876,960,000,000).

- That's strange....well, if you don't believe in the truth of Christianity it is.
- This is **just one amazing fact** about the Bible
  - I **could keep you** here all day explaining hundreds of others **but** this is supposed to be a **short item**.
- The Bible says, about people who refuse to believe it, that they are resisting its truth.
  - In light of this fact, I can see why.
- This one fact alone should convince you that the Bible is the only true Scriptures of God, and the way to salvation and a new beginning.
